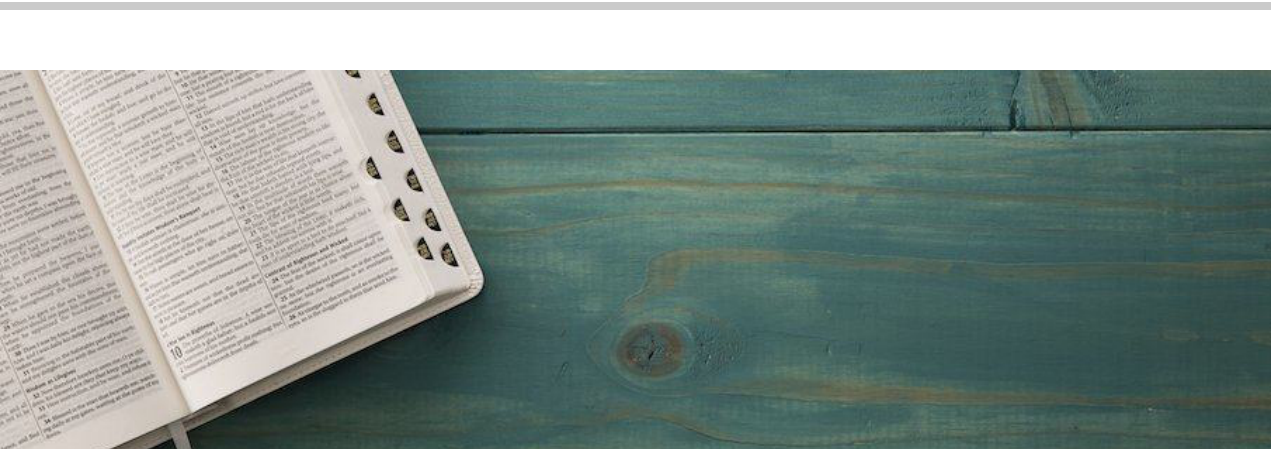

Father Dave's Office Hours

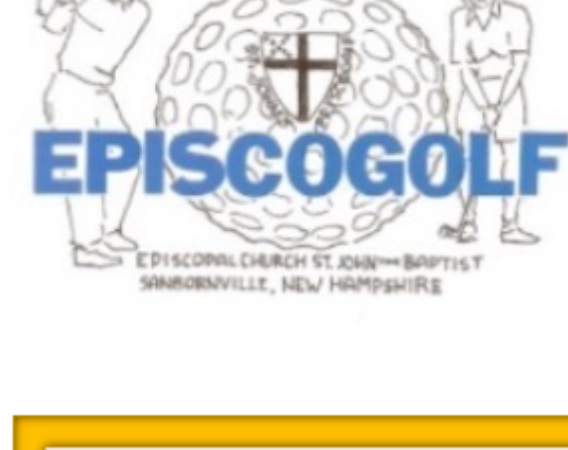
For health and safety Fr. Dave is working from home by phone and Zoom.

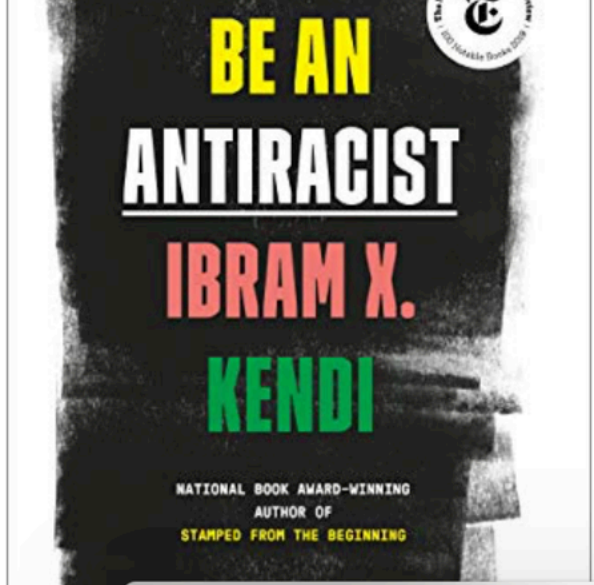

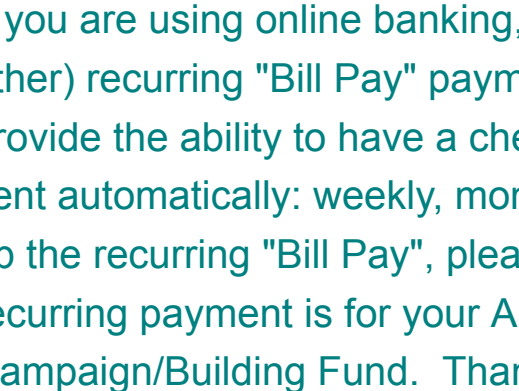
You can lock the doors but you can't close the church!

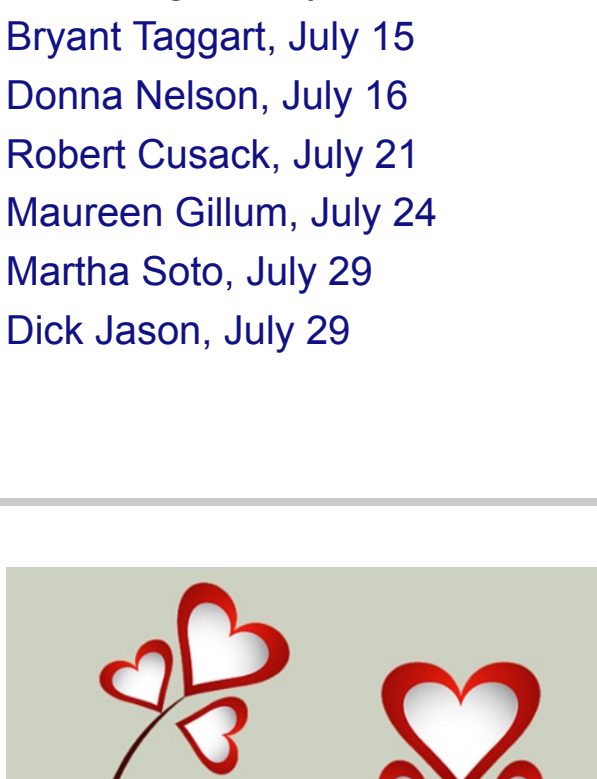

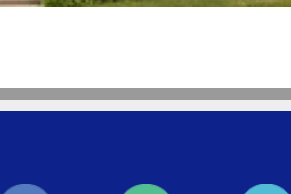
