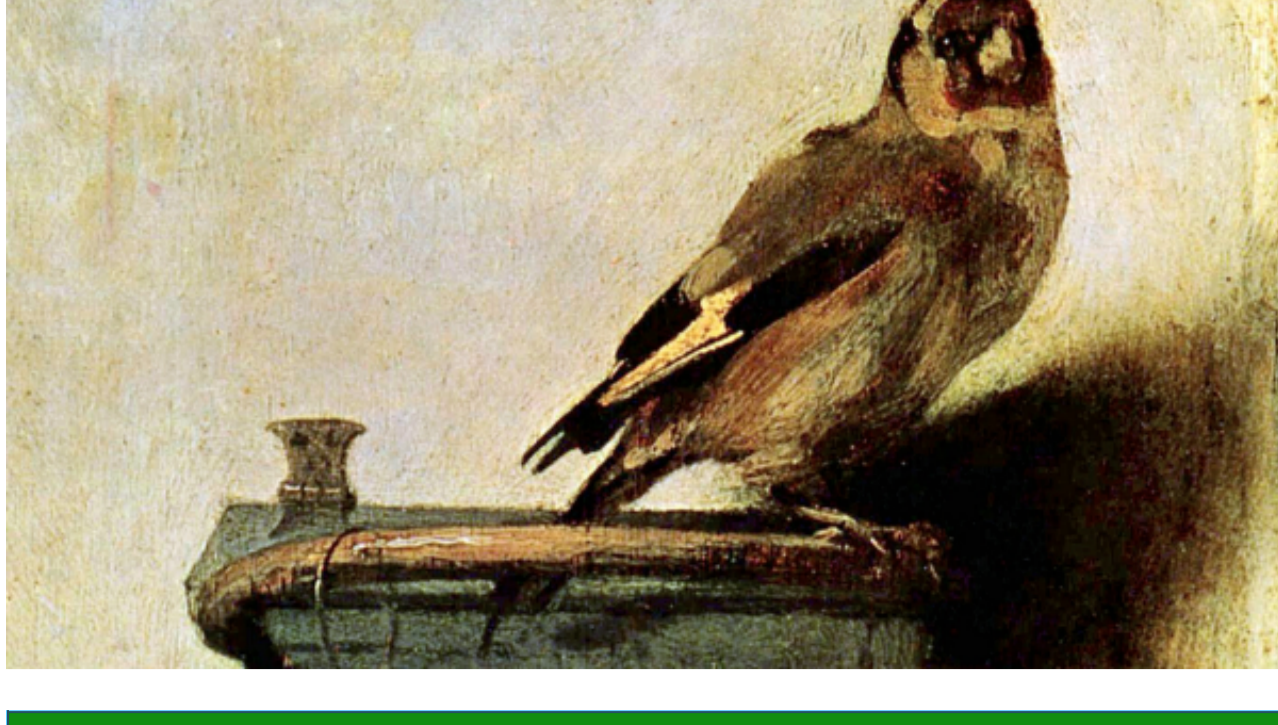

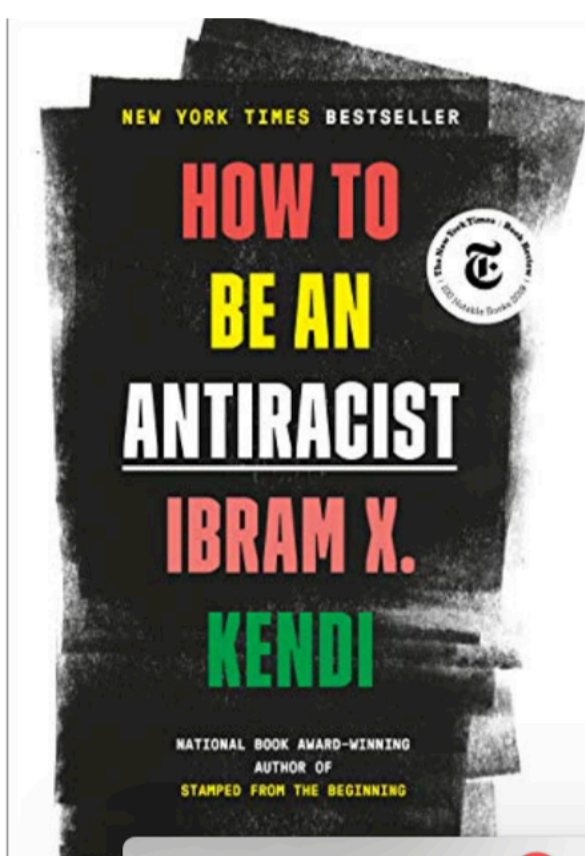

### Work Continues on StJB Addition!

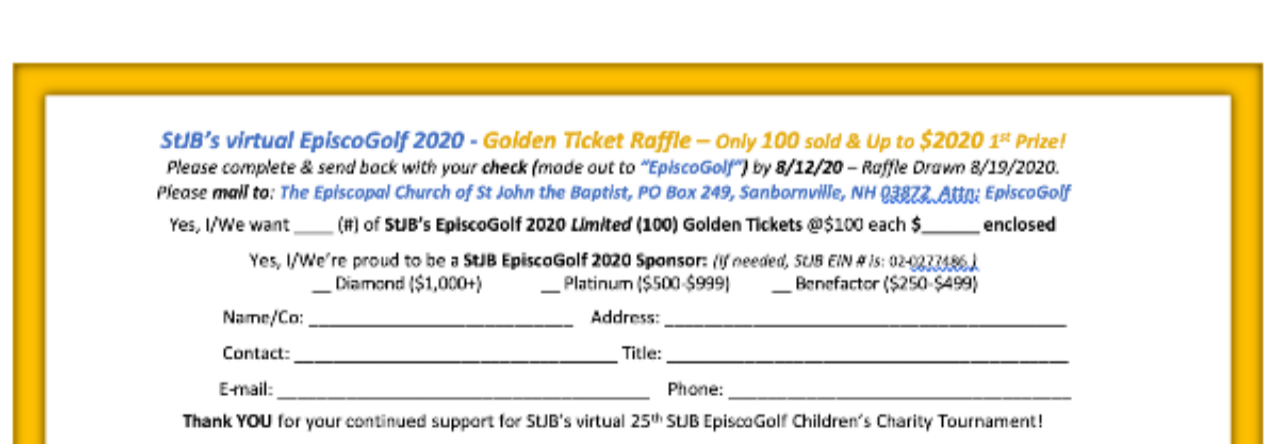
It may not be elegant, but it's important: work continued this week focused on the septic system.
