## From Parson Kit... office hours and more

Wednesday in the Second Week of Lent 2023

Friends in Christ,

As promised Sunday in church, I am sharing my office hours and contact information.

I will be at church in Sanbornville on **Sunday and Wednesday**. I will plan to be in the office on those days. I also plan to hold regular "community office hours" at a place to be determined in town where I can engage with both the parish and the community.

My regular **office hours will be Wednesdays 1-3 pm** for "drop-in" visits. I am happy to meet with you at other times on when I am in the office, or at a mutually convenient location. Please call or email me to schedule. (And it doesn't have to be on a Wednesday!)

I am using the [kiturgy@gmail.com](mailto:kiturgy@gmail.com) address for all correspondence related to the mission and ministry of StJB here in Sanbornville.

My pattern of work is that I take Sabbath time from Sunday late afternoon through Tuesday morning. I will do some church work from home or on the road on Tuesdays and Thursdays, and write my sermon on Saturday. I have a secular job on Fridays. I don't return calls on Mondays or Fridays unless it's a pastoral emergency.

I am grateful for the hospitality shown by those of you who have sent messages to "friend me" on Facebook; as a Safe Church practice, I don't "friend" parishioners on social media.

If you need to speak with me by telephone, feel welcome to call the church office during times I am there. I may also be reached at **207-370-1210**. For non-emergency matters, please call "**between the nines**," that is, between 9:00 am and 9:00 pm, and be prepared to leave a message.

**If you have a pastoral emergency, please call me at 207-370-1210.**

#### What constitutes a pastoral emergency?

It is a pastoral emergency when someone is near death, or has experienced significant trauma for which sacramental and/or prayerful ministry is needed or desired. Some examples: someone has just died, or has been in a serious accident, or is undergoing emergency surgery, or is about to have a baby. This isn't an exhaustive or exclusive list. It demonstrates the scope of what might be considered emergent from a pastoral perspective.

If you are scheduling a surgery or procedure and would like to receive pastoral care before or after, please let me know ahead of time as possible!

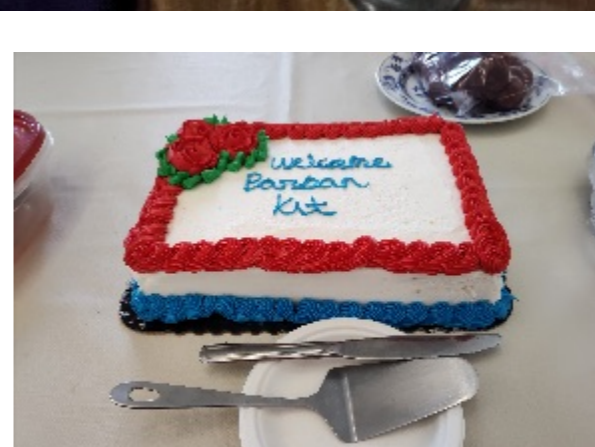
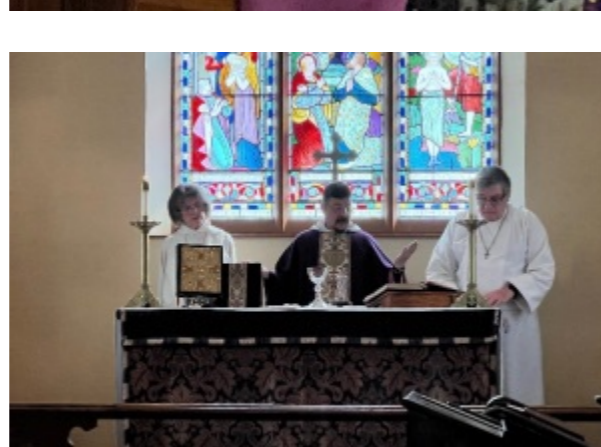
