Walk the path of love with one of the warmest, most beloved spiritual leaders of our time, and learn how to put faith into action.

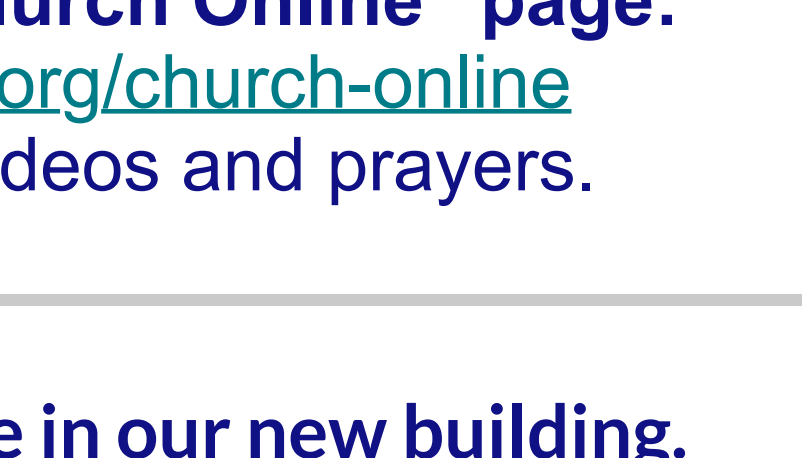

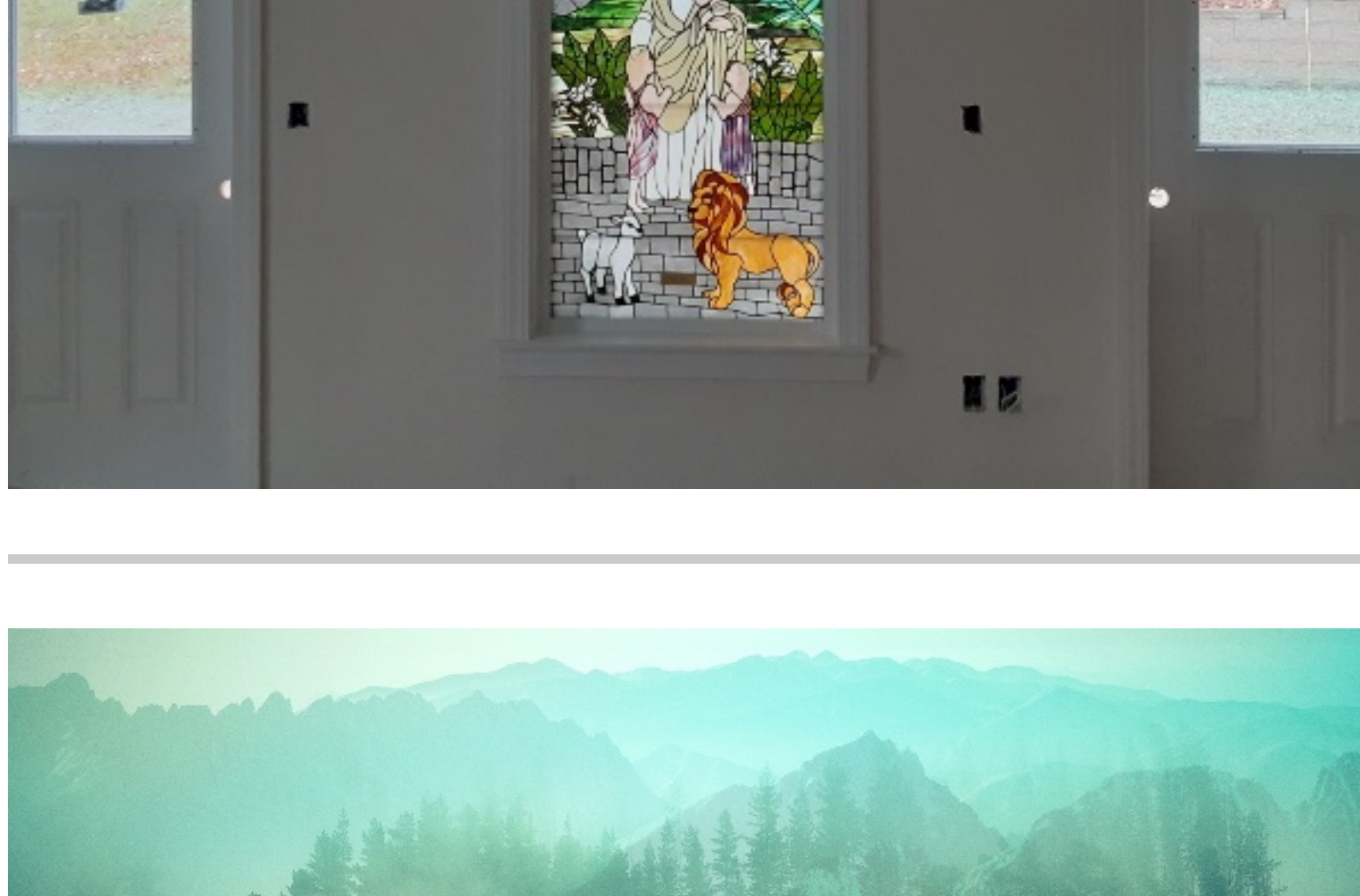
