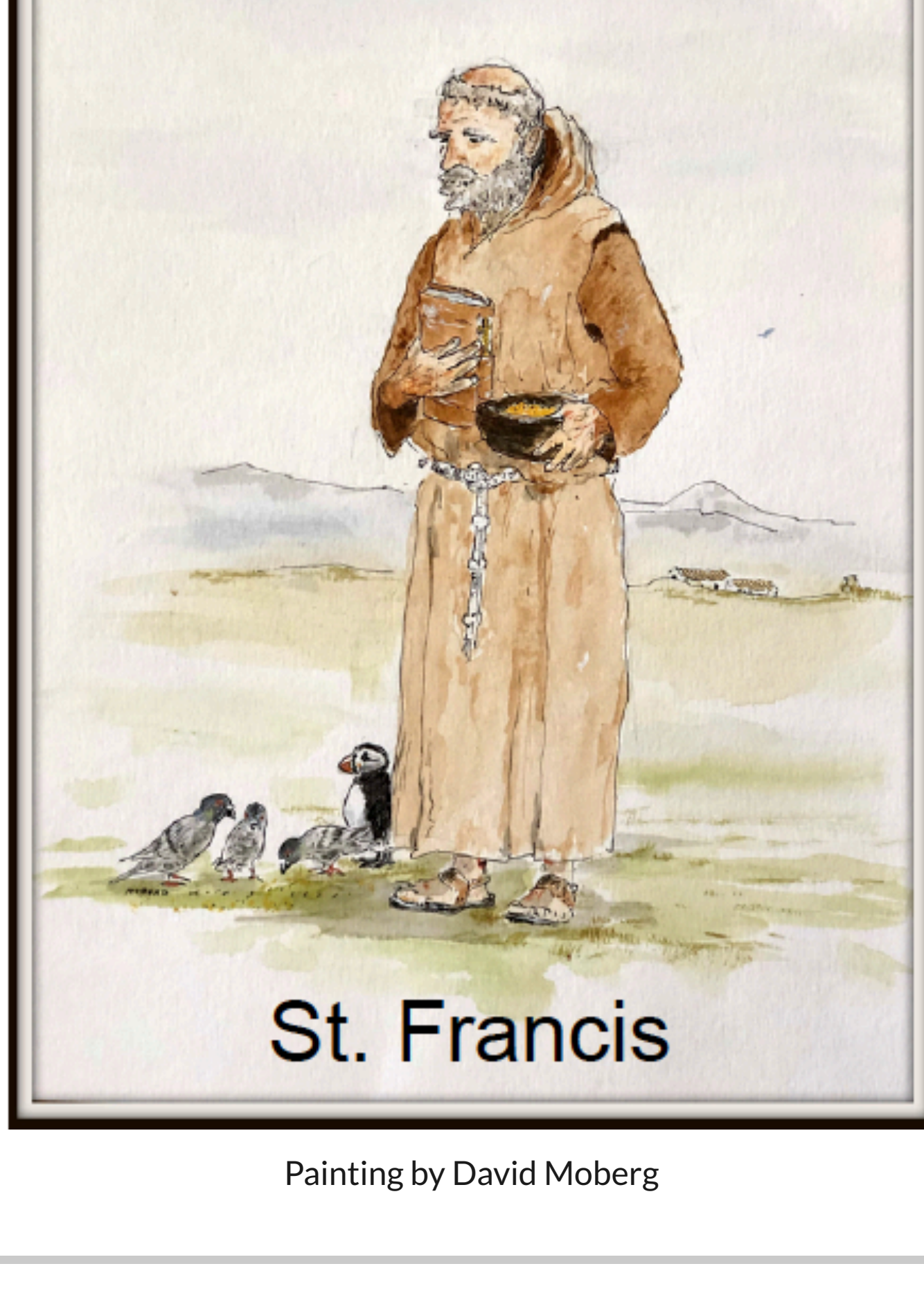

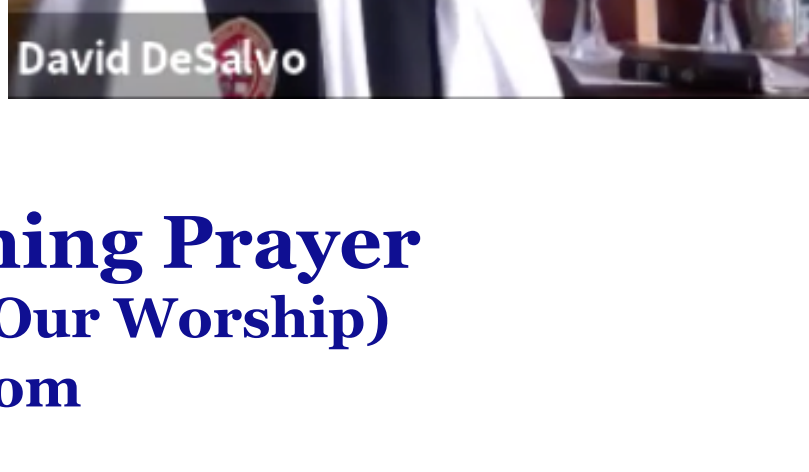


St. Francis

Outdoor Holy Eucharist 5:00 pm in the Church Yard

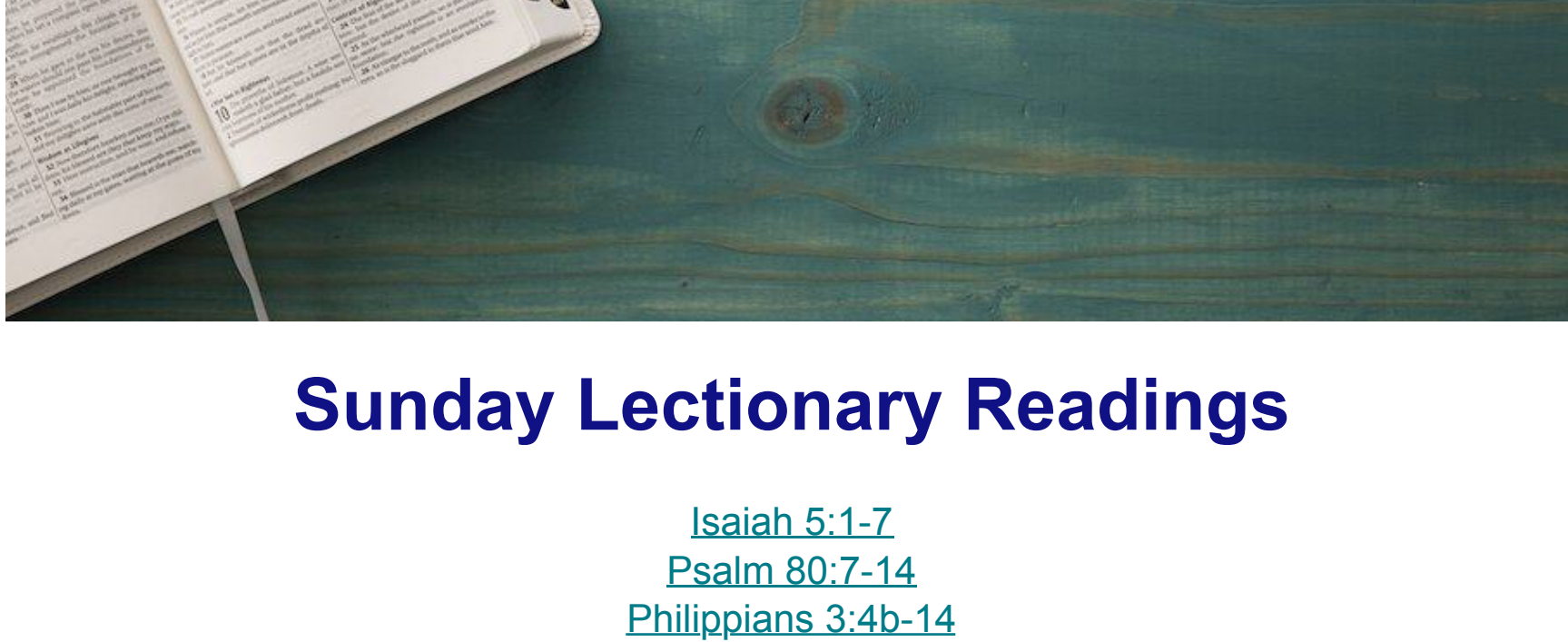

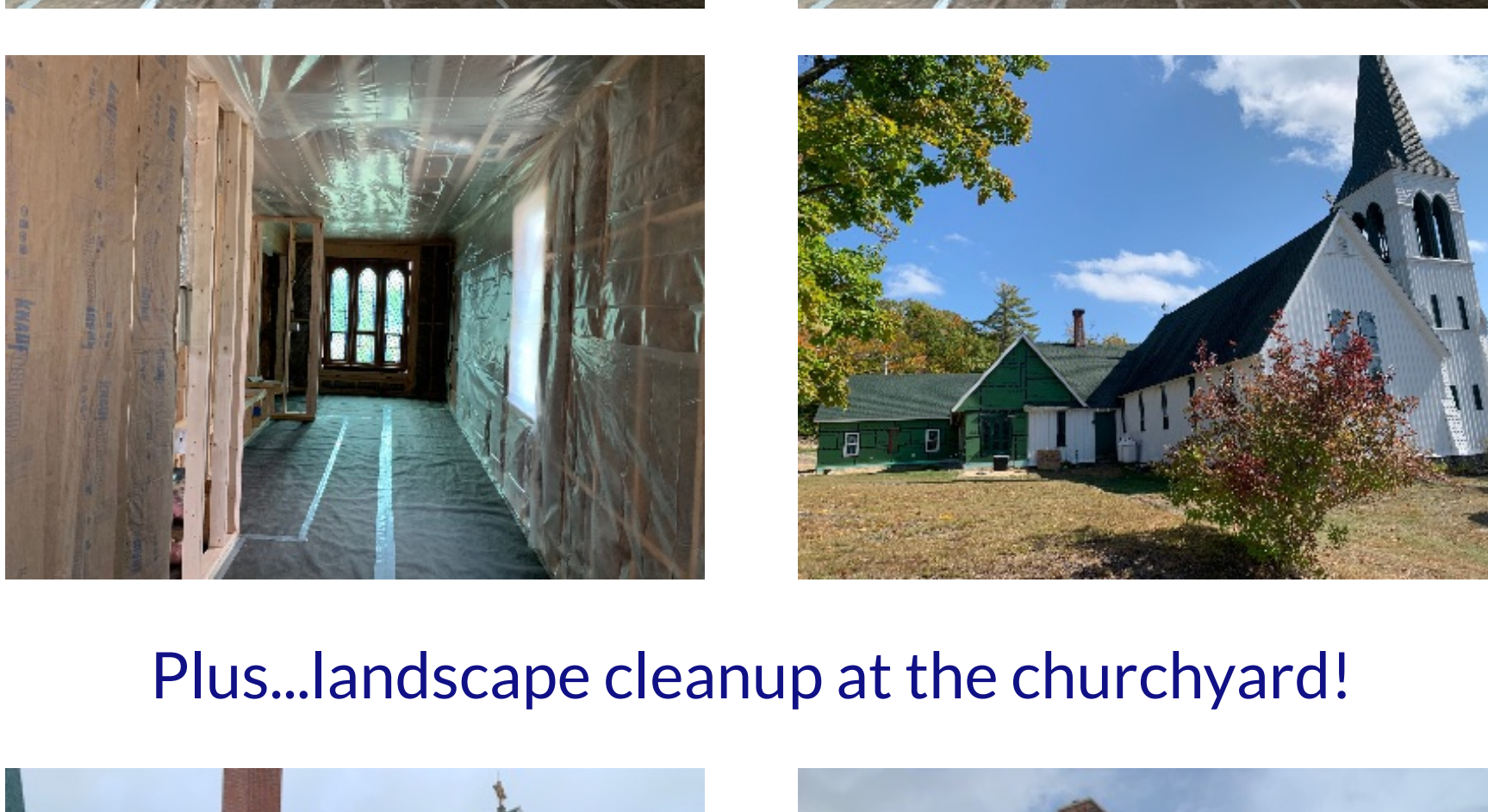

Progress continues on our new building!



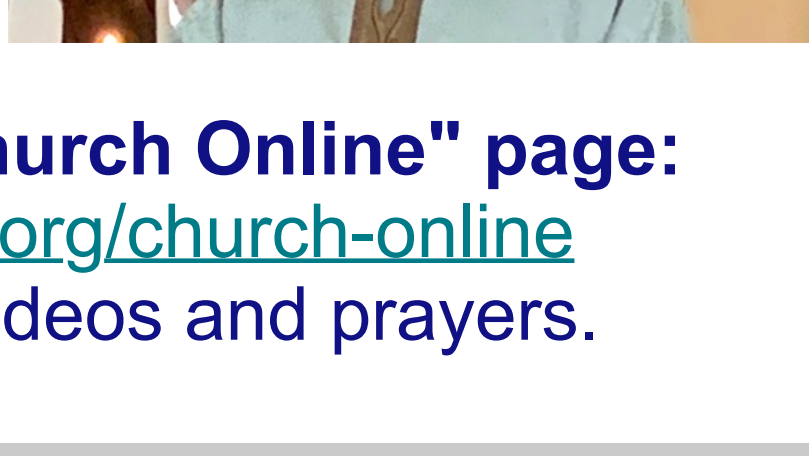
Plus...landscape cleanup at the churchyard!

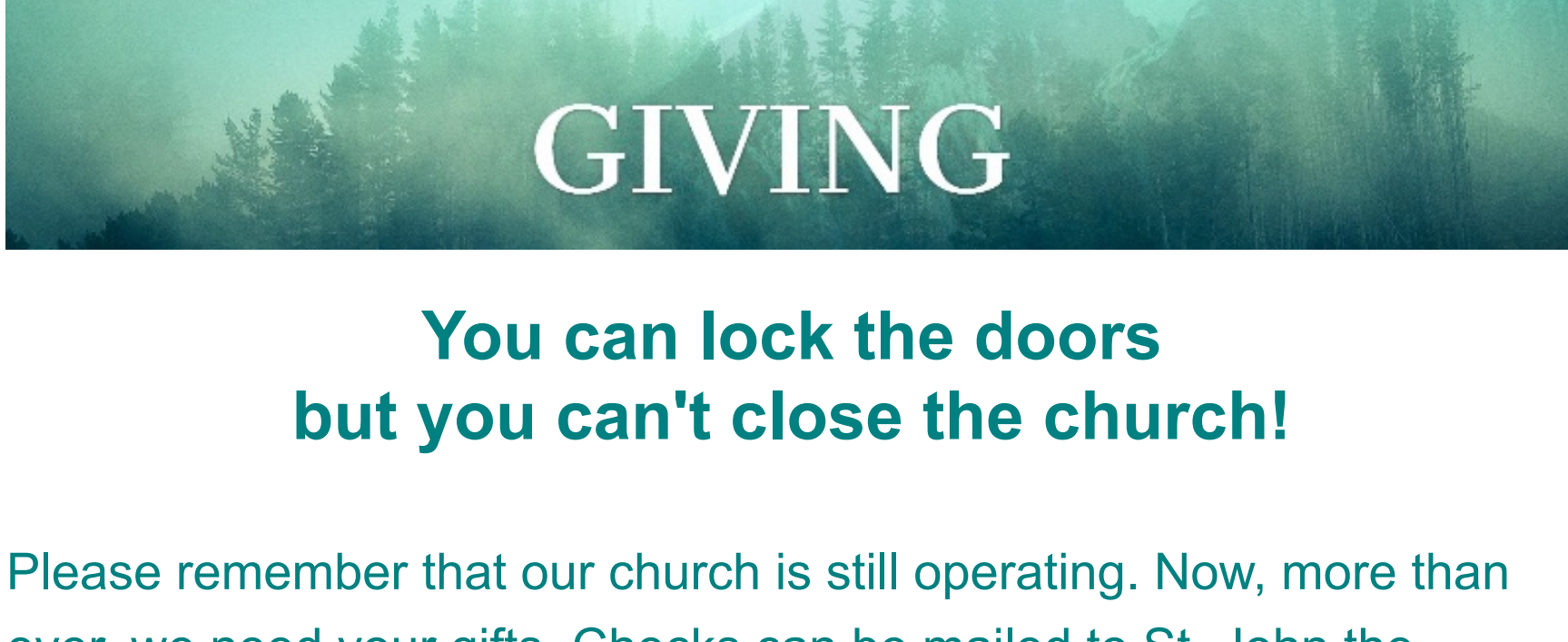

The architectural style and heritage of our church building? The church, built in 1886-7, is typical of one of the most popular styles of the era in which it was built: Gothic Revival. Within that genre it is considered Carpenter Gothic, a North American adaptation of the pointed arches, steep gables and towers of classical Gothic architecture...

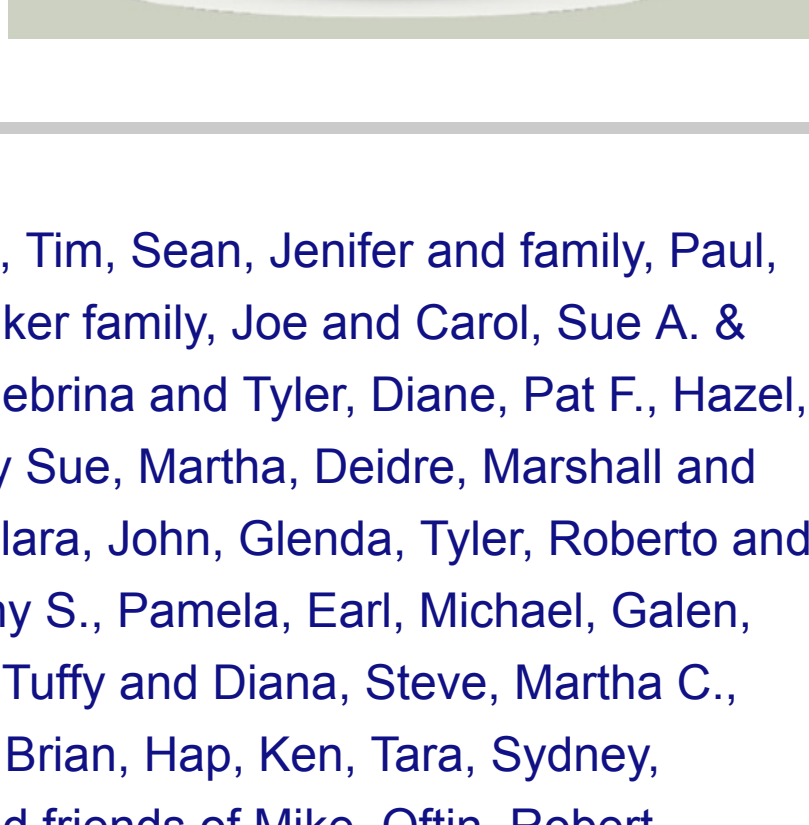
