As always, if you feel flu-like symptoms, please stay home, get well, and we will see you soon.

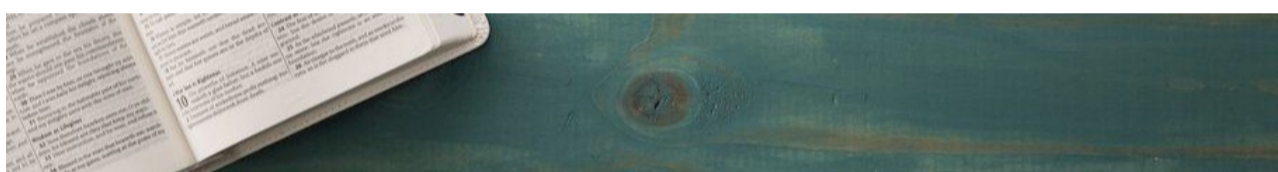

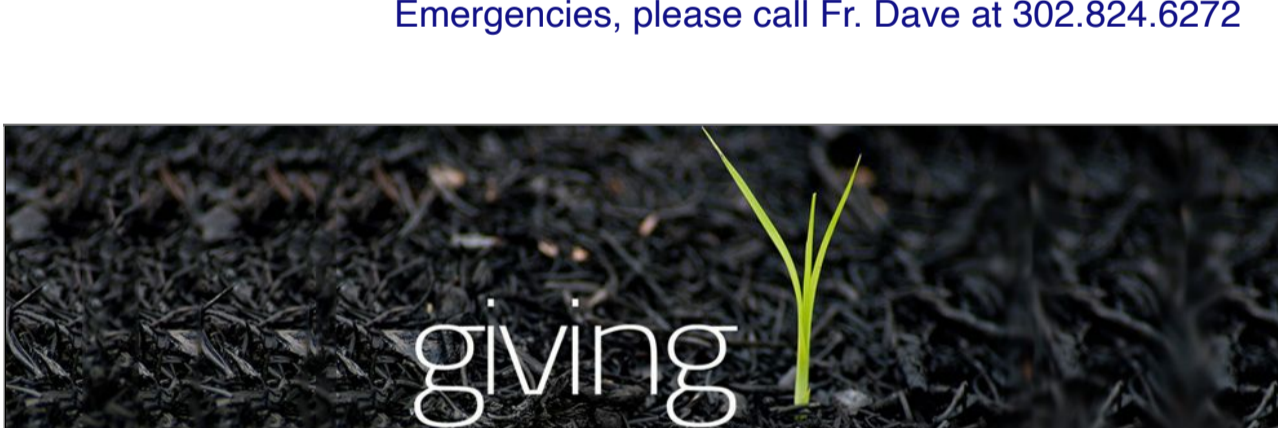

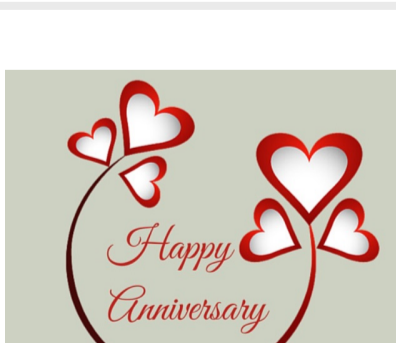
Saving Rebecca Marie:

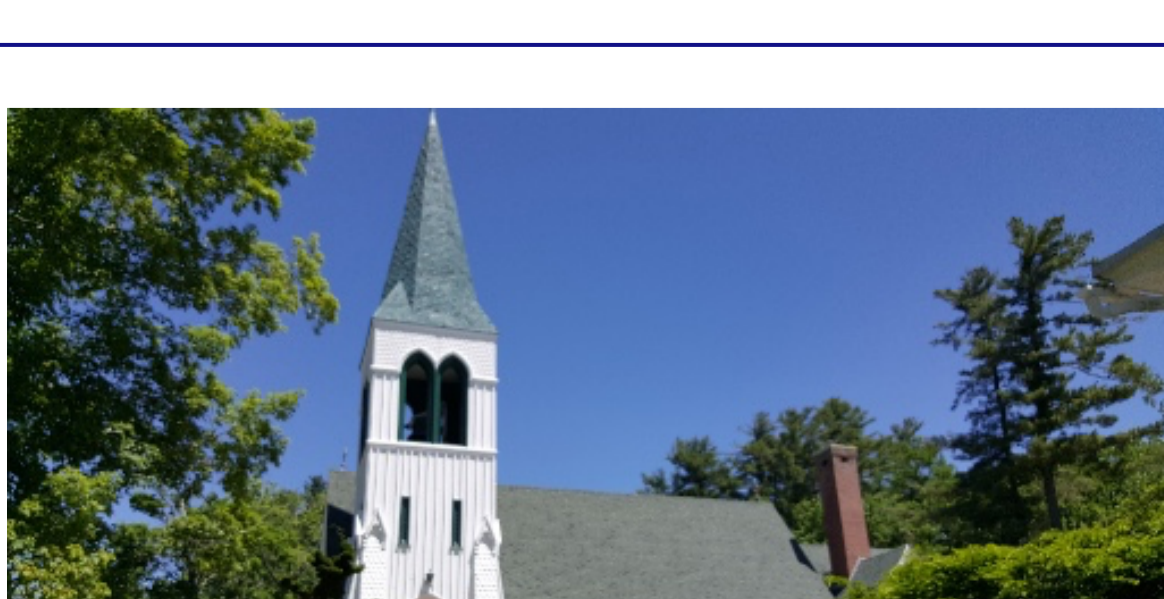
