As we work to complete the amenities for our new Hansen Pike Hall our StJB Wish List 2021 focus is on TWO KEY ITEMS.

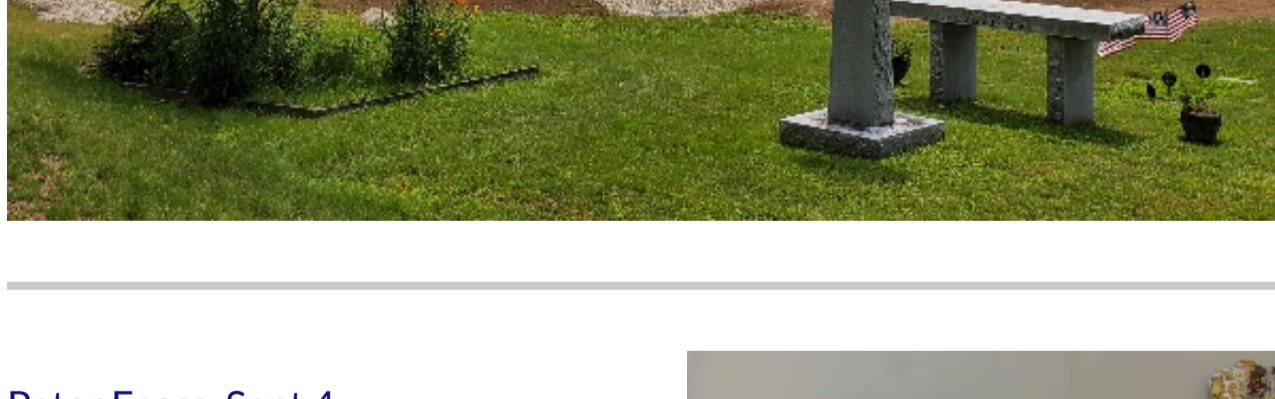
The first is to honor our rich history and the second is to invest in our bright future by funding the (needed but not budgeted) patio. Thank you - your generosity is most needed and much appreciated.



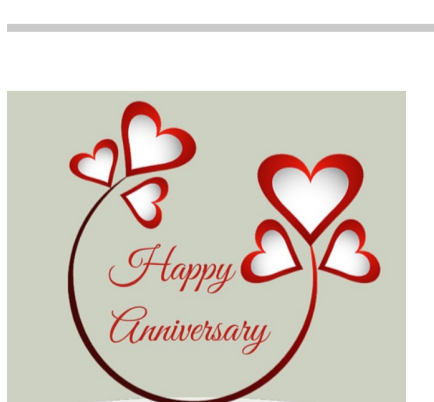
